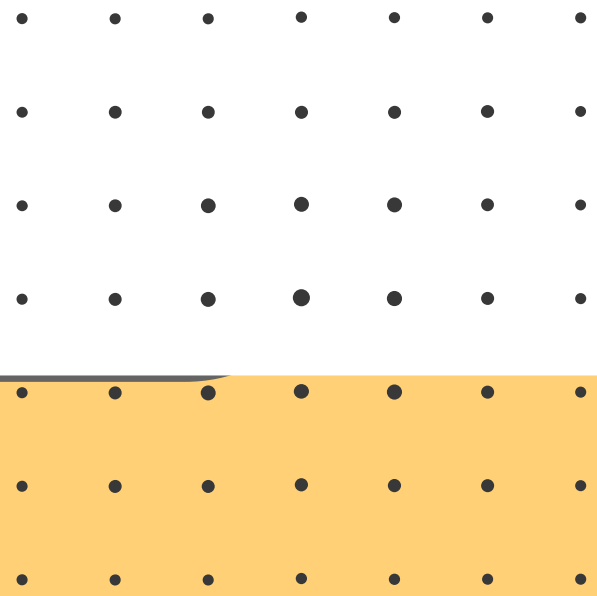
Day's Highlights

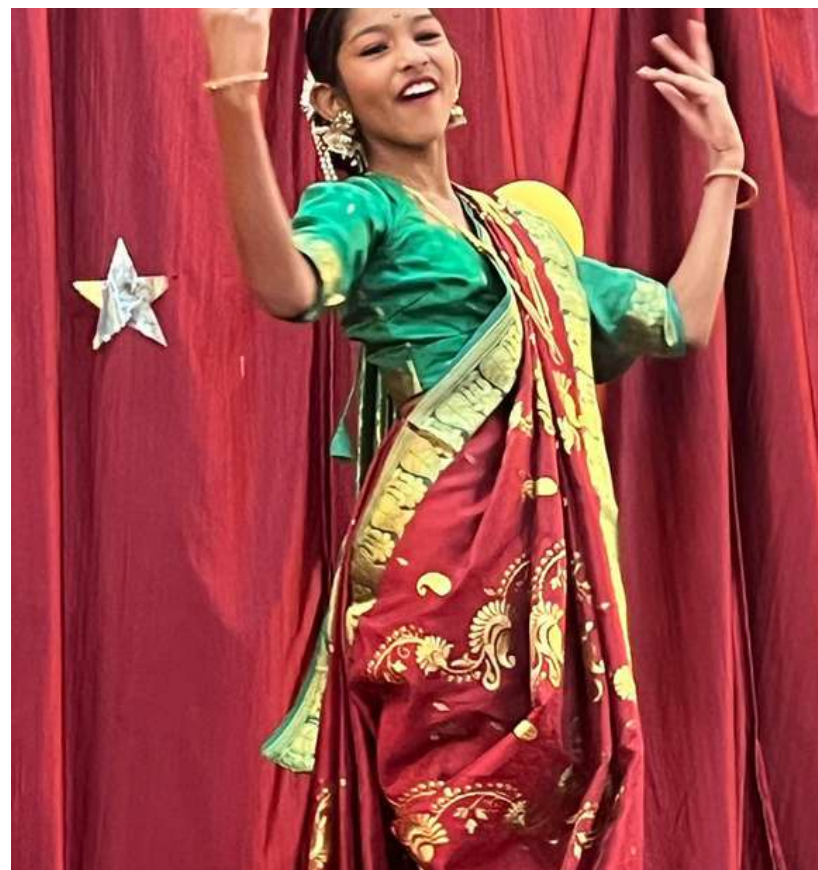
RYTHMS OF TRADITION: FANCY DRESS & DANCE COMPETITION

Day's Highlights

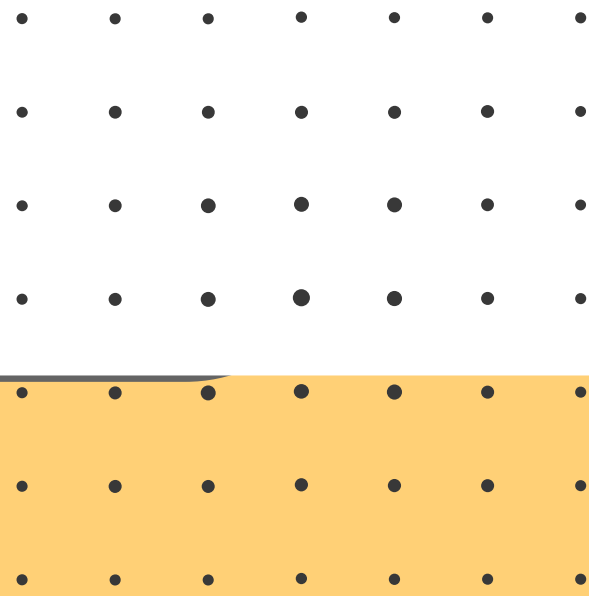

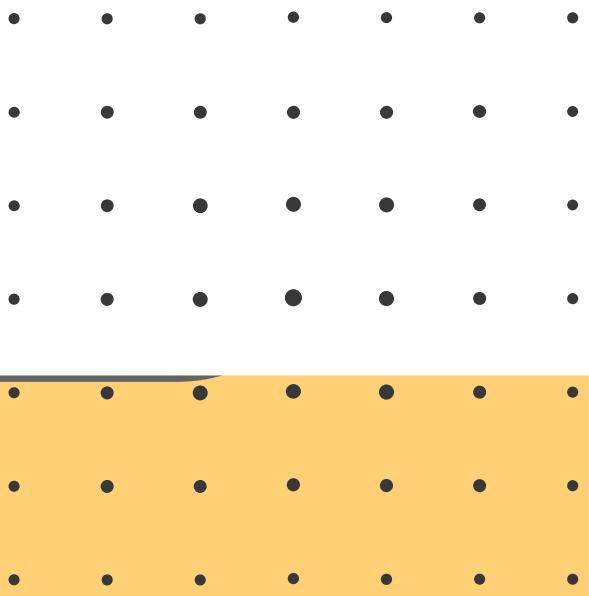




ADVENTURE AND DISCIPLINE:

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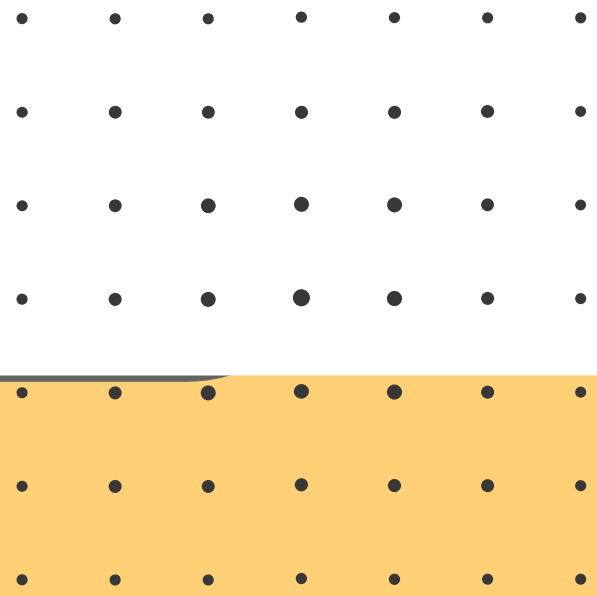
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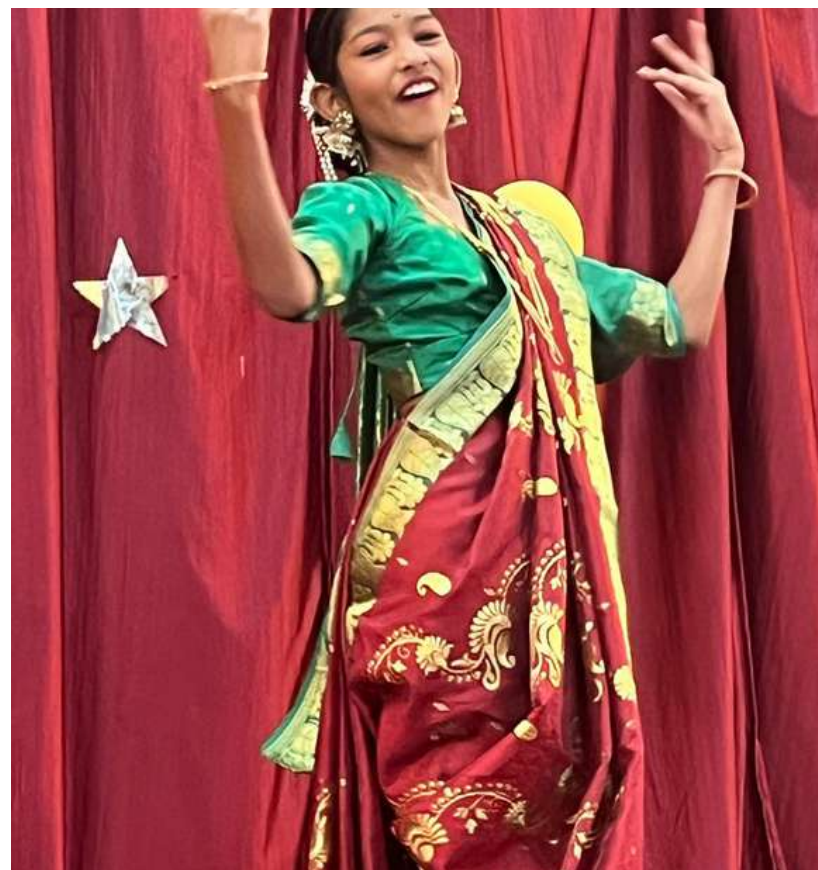
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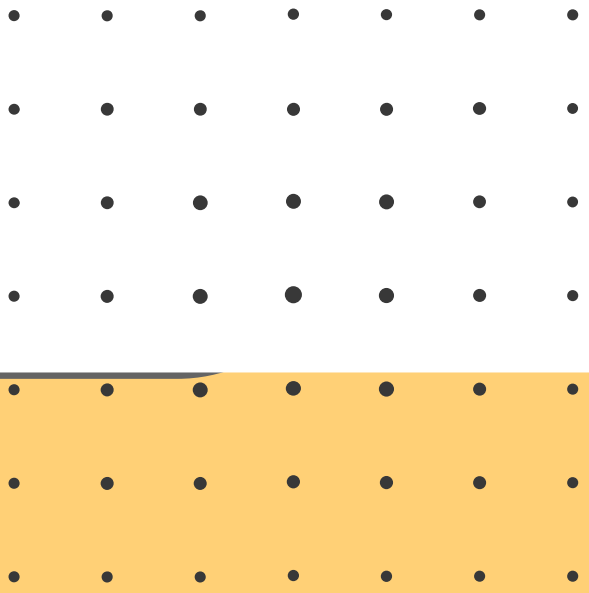
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BITTERSWEET GOODBYE: SSCHOOLBIDS FAREWELL TO CLASS 10

Day's Highlights

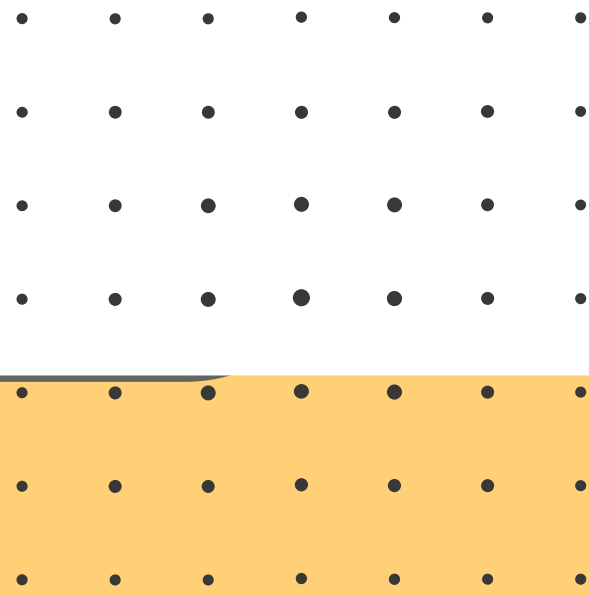

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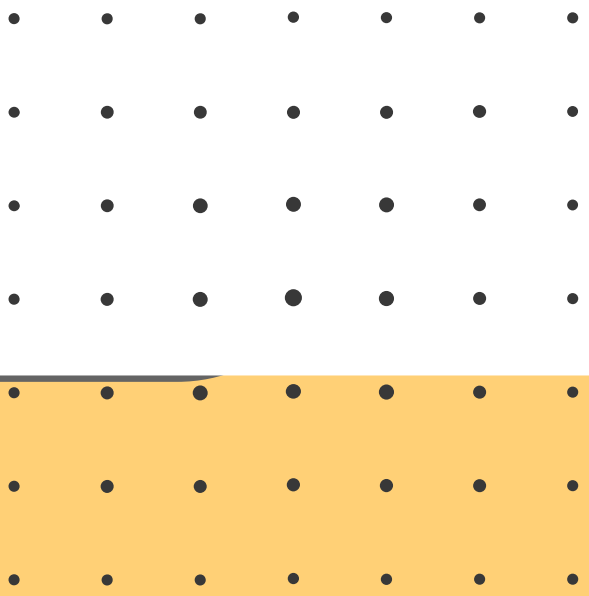
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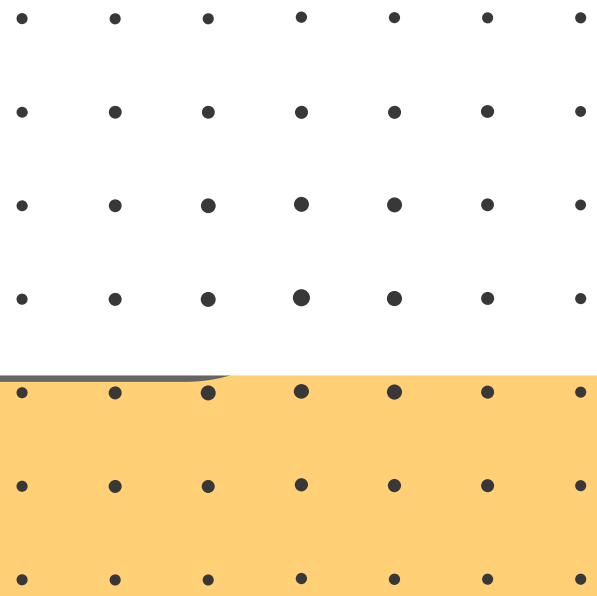
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
